

Connecting to WiscVPN and Mapping to Hasler Lab Server

The campus firewall will filter out all off-campus connections made to campus servers, so in order to connect to the group drive from an off-campus location, you will need to connect to WiscWiscVPN first.

CONNECTING TO WiscVPN:

1. Install [WiscWiscVPN](#), guide on how to connect can also be found on this page
2. For the portal address, use **uwmadison.WiscVPN.wis**

MAPPING TO HASLER LAB NETWORK SERVER:

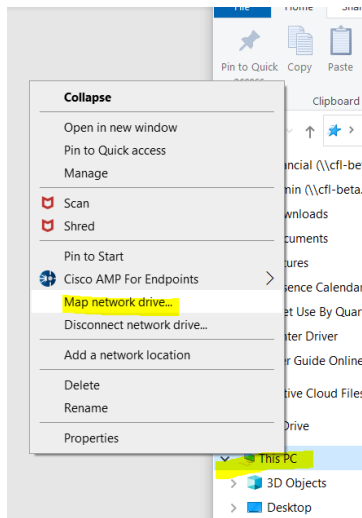
If working remotely, we have to use WiscVPN and non-UW Wi-Fi

If working on campus, we do NOT need to use WiscVPN because will be using UW Wi-Fi

After mapping, if you do not see the folder, you MAY need to restart your computer.

WINDOWS 10 (An additional reference: [Microsoft page for mapping to network drive](#)):

1. Go to File Explorer
2. Right click on This PC from the left pane and select Map network drive.




3. In the Drive list, select O. If you don't have the letter O available any other letters will do the job.

4. If you want to connect to the CFL drive remotely by non-UW Wi-Fi, please make sure you connect with WiscVPN before you do the following step.

Windows instruction:

- a. In the Folder box, type "\\cfl-beta.ad.wisc.edu\groups" - without the quotation marks
- b. Select Finish
- c. When prompted for a credential, use your "ad.wisc.edu\yourNetID" – without the quotation marks - and your netid password

MAC

1. Go to Finder
2. Press Command() + k
3. If you want to connect to the CFL drive remotely by non-UW Wi-Fi, please make sure you connect with WiscVPN before you do the following step.

Mac instruction:

- a. Type in "smb://cfl-beta.ad.wisc.edu/groups", without the quotation marks.
- b. Click on "Connect"
- c. When asked for credential, type in "ad.wisc.edu/yourNetID: - without the quotation marks – and your NetID password.
